**Notes on Coachwork** Coachwork is generally termed as follows:- 2 Seater (*two seats with soft top*), 2 Seater with Dickey, Tourer (*four seats with soft top*), 2 Door Saloon, 2 Door Saloon sliding head, 4 Door Saloon, 4 Door Saloon sliding head, Coupé, Sports or Special Coupé & Traveller's Saloon. (SLIDING HEAD means sunshine roof in modern parlance)
